WORLD BOOK DAY

Dear Parent/Carer,

World Book Day celebrates the joy and value of books and reading, especially for children. To help get them started on their reading journey, every child receives a £1 World Book Day Book Token that can either be exchanged for one of EIGHT special £1 World Book Day books or used to get £1 off any book costing £2.99 or more. Your child's token will be sent home and can be redeemed at most UK bookshops.

World Book Day - Thursday 2nd March

On Thursday 2nd March 2023, to celebrate World Book Day, we shall be participating in lots of activities about books. We would like your child to bring in their favourite book on this day. We will also be creating potato book characters so could you please send your child with a large potato and any craft materials they wish to use to create their character. We will also be providing craft materials in school.

The children will be required to wear school uniform on this day, as normal, as we are not having a dressing up day. We have considered the cost of costumes and have decided that this is an added pressure that families do not necessarily need at this current time.

Book fair - Wednesday 22nd March to Monday 27th March

We shall also be holding our annual Scholastic book fair on Wednesday 22nd March until Monday 27th March and World Book Day vouchers will be valid and redeemable at this event.
