English	<p><b>Macbeth by William Shakespeare</b> Children will access reading, writing and grammar lessons through this text.</p>
Mathematics	<p><b>Maths</b>  <b>Place Value</b> - Read, write, order and compare numbers up to one million. Round numbers within one million to the nearest multiple of powers of ten. Read Roman numerals up to M.  <b>Integer addition and subtraction</b> - Use rounding to estimate. Use a range of mental calculation strategies to add and subtract integers. Illustrate and explain the written method of column addition and subtraction. Select efficient calculation strategies.</p>
Science	<p><b>Evolution</b>            Know how the Earth and living things have changed over time            Know how fossils can be used to find out about the past            Know about reproduction and offspring (recognising that offspring normally vary and are not identical to their parents)            Know how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment            Link adaptation over time to evolution</p>
PE	<p><b>Gymnastics – Body Management</b> Create and perform a sequence of balances with consistency</p> <p><b>Cricket</b> Children will develop throwing, catching, batting and fielding skills</p>
Computing	<p><b>Coding</b>  <i>In this unit the children will begin to explore more complex programming. They will learn how to turn a more complex programme into an algorithm and design and write their own programme.</i></p>
Art	<p><b>2D drawing to 3D making</b> Children will be developing their drawing and modelling skills in this unit.</p>
RE	<p><b>Christianity – Is anything ever eternal?</b>  <i>Explain what Christians might learn about life after death from a Bible story            Ask important questions about eternity and reflect my own beliefs about whether anything is eternal.            Make links between different Christian beliefs and their views on whether anything is ever eternal.</i></p>
Music	<p><b>Melody and Harmony in Music</b> Children will be developing their listen and appraise skills, performance and improvisation in this unit.</p>
PSHE	<p><b>Being me in My World</b> In this unit the children will learn how to recognise challenges and tackle them with positivity. They will learn the rights and responsibilities they have as a British citizen and as a member of our school community.</p>
French	<p><b>Les saisons</b> In this unit the children will be exploring the seasons.</p>
Internet Safety	<p><b>Digital Footprint</b> Children will be learning about their presence online.</p>
