	The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes (Poem) Reading, writing and grammar skills will be taught through this poem study. At the end of the unit, the children will use it to inspire their own poems.
Mathematics	Maths Y6 Consolidation of all areas in preparation for transition to secondary school.
Science	Light In this unit the children will explore how light travels from light sources to our eyes; shadows; how simple optical instruments work (periscopes, telescope, binoculars, mirrors and magnifying glasses).
History	World War II (The Battle of Britain) In this history topic, children will explore why WW2 started, who its leaders were and what is meant by the 'Phoney War' and some of the major events leading up to the Battle of Britain, including the countries involved and the roles they played. They will also learn about what life was like during the bombings 'The Blitz'.
Geography	Biomes and Vegetation Belts Children will explore the layers of the rainforest, locate the world's deserts and discover the animals of the savannah.
PE	Athletics The children will learn to combine movements with fluency and use the correct technique when running, jumping and throwing.
	Hockey The children will learn the skills needed to be able to play a game of hockey and then apply their skills to games.
Computing	Concept Maps In this unit, children will be introduced to concept mapping - a visual representation used when generating and discussing complex ideas. They will create collaborative concept maps and present them to an audience.
Art	Set Design Children will enjoy making models and maquettes as a way to explore set design, linking 3d making to literature, music, film and animation.
Design and Technology	Textiles The children will be designing and making a drawstring bag. They will learn sewing techniques, using pattern pieces and decoration techniques

RE	Islam The children will explore the question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims live good lives?
Music	Race and Exploring identity through Music The children will focus on vocal range, voice change, vocal technique, lyrics (internal rhymes), and anthems.
PSHE/ wellbeing	Relationships In this unit the children will learn how to recognise power and control in relationships and demonstrate ways to stand up for themselves and friends in situations where others are trying to gain power and control.
	Changing Me In this unit the children will explore emotional changes and physical changes to themselves and their bodies. They will also their feelings for transitioning to their next stage in education.
