

Fun Easter Activity Ideas

1. Organise a family egg hunt
2. Decorate an egg
3. Have egg and spoon races in the garden
4. Make a craft Easter chick
5. **Make Easter masks** - be a bunny, chick, lamb or something else seasonal. Have an adult cut out the eye holes, then have lots of fun decorating with paint, stickers, string or wool for hair, cotton balls for wool, etc. You could use card to cut out extra pieces (eg bunny ears) and stick them on too.
6. Decorate an Easter bonnet (this can be any type of hat or cap)
7. Decorate an Easter tree (just use a branch from your garden)
8. Make Easter decorations
9. Plant flowers
10. Enjoy playing board games together
11. **Egg Collage** - give each child a piece of paper and draw a big egg shape outline on it. With a pot of paste and scraps of material or ribbon they can make their own creative picture.
12. Have an indoor picnic
13. **Precision Roll** - Find a long clear space on the floor. Place a tin from the cupboard at one end of the room, kids at the other. Each child has one chance to roll the ball as near to the tin as possible. Use a tape measure to record the distance for each child, closest wins.
14. **Bat and Ball keepy-uppy** - Use a soft indoor friendly ball, sponge balls are ideal. Each child takes turns with the bat to see how many taps they can keep the ball in the air.

15. **Make an Easter bunny sock puppet** - Use buttons or cut out pieces of paper or card for eyes and a nose and hey presto! You have all you need to create your own Easter bunny puppet show.

16. **Read spring or Easter themed books**

17. **Make Easter cards** You can use scraps of paper, old birthday and [Christmas cards](#), magazines etc.

18. **Easter themed baking - we love these bunny paw biscuits**
