### Week 3: Nature

This week our family project will be based on nature.

Here are some ideas for activities:

#### Nature

-Go for a nature walk together as a family. Take photos of different aspects of nature that you see on your way.

- Collect different leaves. How many different types can you find? Try to identify tree they are from. Then use them to do some leaf rubbings.

- Start a nature journal. Record all your wildlife observations (any animals you spot). Write down the times. Do you see any at similar times?

- Make an insect hotel. All you will need are a few things from outside. Click the link for instructions.

- Go on a nature scavenger hunt. Work together to create a list of natural objects you can find outside during the summertime (such as a bird feather, wildflowers, and a green leaf.) After you make your list, grab a paper bag and set out to find each item.

-Make a bird feeder to get a close look at the birds in your yard. Simply string popcorn, berries, raisins, fruit, and anything else you think birds might like to eat on a sturdy piece of string. Loop your string around a tree in your yard and watch as birds flock to your homemade feeding station!

- Create a nature collage with leaves, sticks, flowers etc. that you have collected on your nature walk.

- On a nice day lay on the ground and look up to the sky (not directly at the sun) look at the clouds use your imagination to see if you can see any pictures in the sky. Can you all see the same thing? Do you see different things to each other?
