Keep your family entertained during the holidays with these suggested activities


Week 6: Living in history

This week our family project will be based on the events of 2020. We are forming a part of history with the recent COVID 19 pandemic. This week you are going to make a family keepsake about the events. This will be an amazing resource to look back on as a family in years to come.

Here are some ideas for activities:

COVID 19 PANDEMIC

- Make a family keepsake scrapbook and include the following things
- What is a pandemic? How is it different to an epidemic?
- Where did the virus originate? How did the authorities try to stop the spread?
- Using a world map colour all of the countries affected by the COVID 19 pandemic?
- Draw/ paint or collage an image of what you think the virus looks like?
- What did the UK do to try and stop the spread? Think about the dates of lockdown, when things relaxed etc.
- Make a poster about how families entertained themselves during lockdown. Think about the things that you did during lockdown. Include things that you enjoyed and things that you found difficult.
- Perhaps write a diary entry for a typical day in lockdown.
- Make a list of items that were hard to buy e.g. toilet rolls, flour etc.
- You could make a photo collage of the things that you did with your family.
- Were there any symbols that people displayed in their windows? Go for a walk together and take photographs of positive symbols to help decorate your scrapbook. Or weekly routines of thanks?
- Design a face mask.
- Now looking forward what do we need to do to ensure that we keep safe from this virus while starting to return to normal life?
- Include anything else that you think is relevant. Remember this is your scrapbook to keep and will form part of history.
